

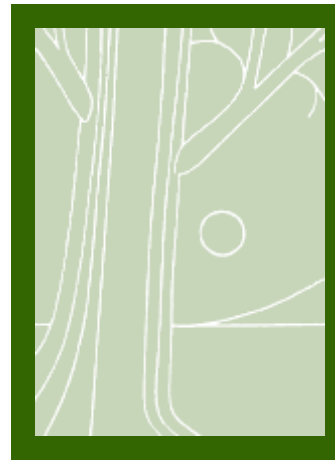

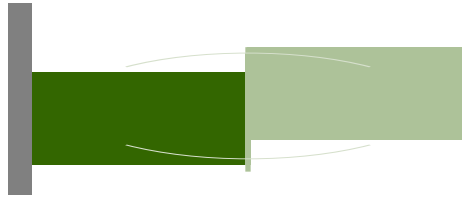

Northwoods offers vocational training that provides the opportunity and experience to get ready for competitive employment in the community.

Trained staff provide a continuum of services that allows an individual to learn or progress at their own pace and comfort level. Consideration is given to physical or learning needs with accommodations put in place to assist a person to reach their optimal independence and potential. A variety of worksites are used for training purposes. Follow-up services are provided to ensure maintenance of a productive quality of life.

Vocational Training Can Provide:

- Learning acceptable work behavior
- Gaining work skills
- Getting into condition for work
- Building/increasing physical tolerance
- Recognizing abilities and gaining developing self confidence
- Becoming a self advocate with employers and coworkers
- Obtaining work experience
- Integrating adaptive needs



Northwoods works in cooperation with an individual and their support systems including, families, guardians, schools, and/or financial and funding agencies to assist in evaluating and planning for the person to obtain and hold a job in the community of their choice. Consideration is given to all aspects of a person's life and the needs that they may have including, but not limited to housing, transportation, medical, and financial.

Northwoods works with agencies such as Social Security, residential and adult family homes, schools, county human services, and care management organizations.
